They also expressed their opinion on which ones they like and dislike.

Mwynhaodd ein myfyrwyr ddysgu am sbectrwm amrywiol Awtistiaeth a'r ffyrdd niferus y gallwn greu amgylcheddau mwy cynhwysol. It's been a powerful reminder of how we can all contribute to a more inclusive world.

This half term, the children have been learning about solid, liquid and gas properties and have developed a sound understanding of this. They particularly enjoyed learning how properties change with heat when creating their rice krispies cakes!

The Chair of the Governor's and our School Improvement Partner have both been impressed by how well they work in numeracy during their visits to our class this half term. Our Science lessons have focussed on changing matter and pupils have learnt about solid, liquid and gas which finished with weighing fruit at the beginning of the week and at the end of the week and seeing and explaining why there was a difference.

I've been extremely proud of them all as we've learnt about Down's Syndrome and Autism for their respective awareness days, and how they embrace differences. Da iawn chi!
